Tories throw away £1.6m on botched tender process

The Conservative councillors running Oxfordshire County Council are under fire for trying to cover up a massive £1.6 million loss due to a botched contract.

The council paid out £1 million in compensation and a further £600K in legal fees over the cock up.

They then sat on the information for nearly a year before telling councillors from other parties.

"This is shocking. That money could have paid for vital local services," said Cllr Liz Leffman.

"What's worse, not a single one of them has had the decency to apologise to local taxpayers."
